Thursday 16th May - Census Day

Thursday 16th May is census day where all children attending the school will be counted. It is very important that your child is in school on this day as this determines how much money the school receives from the Local Authority.

We would also ask that you encourage your child to take a hot meal provided by our caterers (it is free for infant children) on this day. The school receives additional money from the Local Authority for every hot meal taken.

Aspirations Day

On **Wednesday 22nd May** we are having an 'Aspirations Day'. **Children can come to school dressed as 'what they would like to be when they grow up'**. Please talk to your child about what they would like to be when they grow up. A poster will be displayed outside your child's class with ideas of what this could be.

Attendance Reminders

- If your child needs to have a medical or dental appointment we ask that, if possible, you book this outside of school hours so that they do not miss any of their learning time.
- If your child does need to have an appointment during school hours, please remember to inform the school office the time you will be collecting them as well as your child's class teacher. Please bring your child back to school after the appointment unless the medical expert has advised you not to.
- If the appointment is for a parent or sibling please ensure your child still attends school by making alternative arrangements to drop your child to school or collect at the end of the day.

- If a child is not collected at the correct time and no contact has been made by their parent or carer by 4:30pm, we will inform Children's Services who will advise us about the next steps.
