Diwali - Tuesday 1st November



Children can wear traditional or party clothes in recognition of Diwali, also known as the Festival of Lights, which is celebrated by Sikhs and Hindus. The main theme of the celebration is the triumph of light over darkness and good over evil. On the main festival night, *Deepavali*, Hindus dress up in new clothes or their best outfit, light up <u>diyas</u> (lamps and candles) inside and outside their home, participate in family *puja* (prayers) typically to Lakshmi - the goddess of wealth and prosperity. After *puja*, fireworks traditionally follow.



Children In Need - Friday 18th November

As a school we select certain charities to support and the annual **Children in Need** appeal is a popular one, with many positive messages about how the money raised is spent and lots of entertaining coverage that the children can relate to.
