#### News from Nursery

This term we have been learning about 'ourselves'. We have talked about how we have changed since being a baby and about our body. We have painted our faces for a display, drawn around our bodies and added facial features. We have also been sorting toys we played with as babies and those we play with now.

This week we have been discussing our senses. We have investigated smelly pots, looked at and felt natural objects, listened to hidden sounds and used our sense of taste in our first cooking activity!

#### News from Year One

This week we have been for a walk to the local shops as part of our geography curriculum to learn about the local area. We have also been on an Autumn Walk on our field and have been learning all about using our senses.

In Art, we have been making portraits. The Modroc sculptures have been sent home for you to keep and our classrooms are now beautifully decorated with painted self portraits of the children. We have been learning all about 2 and 3 dimensional shapes. Can you ask your child to name any shapes at home? e.g. a beans tin is a cylinder shape or a football is a sphere.

#### News from Year Two

The children in Year 2 have been working incredibly hard and have already been making super progress. We are the first year group to perform our class assemblies. Thank you to all that came, we are really proud of how well the children learnt their lines and projected their voices in the hall. Literacy - The children have continued to learn and apply a weekly spelling rule. Please continue to read with the children as much as possible at home, it really does make a difference. Maths - The children have been learning to count forwards and backwards in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10.
