Attendance Reminders

This time of year is a very important time for children as they transition to their new year group. Some things to think about:

- Your child's attendance percentage need to be at or above 96% before it can be considered good.
- An attendance record of 90% is equal to 1 day missed every 2 weeks.
- An attendance record of 80% is equal to 1 day missed per week.
- It is important that your child is given every opportunity to learn and fulfil their potential.
- A whole year has 365 days; a school year has 190 days. That leaves 175 days to spend on family time, holidays, visits, shopping and other experiences.

Recent 'School timings' questionnaire


