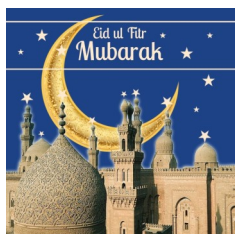
Dear Parents/Carers,

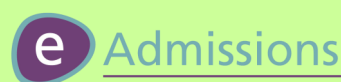


Reception and Year 3 School Place Offers

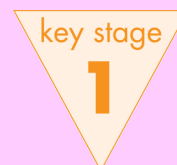

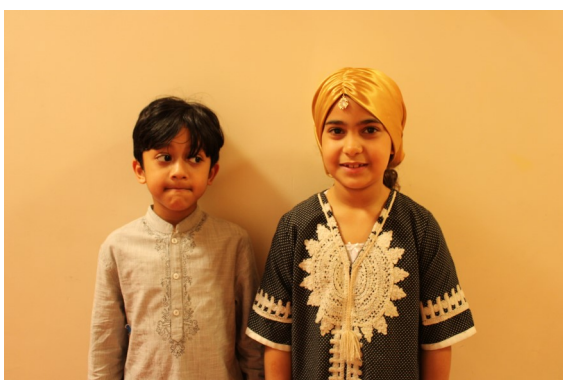
Summer Weather reminders

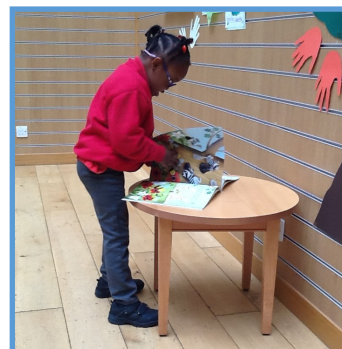


Living Eggs—Children have been learning about changing and growing as well as animals during the living eggs visit. We said goodbye to our chicks this morning as they make their way back to the farm.

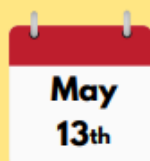
